GUIDELINES ON THE ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS
TO ASSOCIATE DEGREE AND UNDERGRADUATE
PROGRAMS

(Adopted at the meeting of the Senate of the Lokman Hekim University on 11 January 2019, revised at the meetings of 04 March, 24 April, 19 July, 21 November 2019, 13 August 2020, and reviewed and approved by YOK at the meeting of the Council of Higher Education on 11 March 2020)

PART ONE
Purpose, Scope, Basis

Purpose

ARTICLE 1- (1) The purpose of this Guidelines is to set out the principles for the admission of foreign students to associate degree and undergraduate programs at Lokman Hekim University.

Scope

ARTICLE 2- (1) This Directive includes the conditions for determining the quota, application, admission and assessment regarding the admission of foreign students.

Basis

ARTICLE 3- (1) This Guidelines is based on the Principles for Admission of Foreign Students adopted at the meeting of the General Assembly of Higher Education on 13.12.2015.

Definitions

ARTICLE 4- (1) In this Guidelines,

- a) University (LHU) shall mean the Lokman Hekim University.
- b) Rector shall mean the Rector of Lokman Hekim University.
- c) Senate shall mean the Senate of Lokman Hekim University.
- d) Faculty shall mean the Faculties of Lokman Hekim University.
- e) Vocational School shall mean the Vocational Schools of Lokman Hekim University.
- f) LHUYOS shall mean the Lokman Hekim University Foreign National (International) Student Exam.
- g) English Preparation Program shall mean the English Preparation Program of Lokman Hekim University.
- h) English Proficiency Exam shall mean the English Proficiency Exam of Lokman Hekim University.
- i) SAT shall mean the world-wide Scholastic Aptitude Test of United States of America to study in the American universities.
- j) GCE shall mean the General Certificate of Education to study in English universities.
- k) ACT shall mean the American College Testing that is a standard test to go to colleges in the United States of America.
- l) Abitur shall mean the German Baccalaureate Test.
- m) IB shall mean the International Baccalaureate.
- n) International Relations Office shall mean the Lokman Hekim University International Students and Academic Relations Office.
- o) Foreign National Student shall mean any student who graduated from a school equivalent to Turkish high schools, but who is not a citizen of the Republic of Turkey or the TRNC, or if the student is a dual citizen, a student whose one of his/her nationalities is not

Republic of Türkiye and/or TRNC.

p) YOK shall mean the Council of Higher Education of Republic of Türkiye.

PART TWO

Principles for Admission of Students

Quota

ARTICLE 5- (1) The quota to be allocated to the associate degree and undergraduate programs of the units that accept students from abroad and the special conditions shall be determined by the proposal of the Senate and the decision of the Board of Overseers, and shall become final after the approval of the Council of Higher Education.

- (2) In case the quotas allocated to the programs for the admission of students from abroad are not filled, upon the request by the University, unfulfilled quotas can be transferred to other programs of the same university by the relevant committees of the University, provided that they do not exceed 50% of the quotas of the programs in the YKS Higher Education Programs and Quotas Guide, and provided that they are the programs other than Medicine, Dentistry, and Pharmacy. In the case of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy programs, the unfilled quotas can be transferred upon the request of the University and the decision of the Higher Education Executive Board, provided that they do not exceed 50% of the quotas of the programs included in the YKS Higher Education Programs and Quotas Guide.
- (3) Pursuant to Article 45/f of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, amended by Law No. 6287, adopted at the meeting of the General Assembly of Higher Education dated 04.07.2019, and the Principles Regarding the Admission of Students from Abroad, determined by the Council of Higher Education as well as the Principles for Admission of Foreign Students of 2019, for candidates with a blue card who have the opportunity to apply for student admission quotas from abroad, and Turkish nationals who have completed their high school education abroad (except for the TRNC), and candidates with dual nationality, one of which is Turkish, 10% of the quota of the aforementioned programs must not be exceeded while enrolling in Teaching, Law, Medicine and Dentistry programs.
- (4) Lokman Hekim University is free to fill its quotas or not.

Basic Requirements

ARTICLE 6- (1) Applications from the following candidates are accepted:

Provided that they are in the last year of high school or have graduated;

- a) For foreign nationals:
- b) Those who are Turkish citizens by birth and who have a permit from the Ministry of Interior to renounce their Turkish citizenship, and those who certify that their underage children, who are registered in the certificate of renunciation of Turkish citizenship, have a Document on the Exercise of the Rights Granted in accordance with the Turkish Citizenship Law (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 provides that “(1) A child born in a marriage union from a Turkish citizen mother or father in or out of Turkey is a Turkish citizen”, and candidates who apply for admission quotas from abroad should review the Turkish Citizenship Law).

- c) Among the Turkish students who continued their secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013, those who completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC)
 - d) Candidates who started secondary education abroad after 01/02/2013, completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the TRNC, (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC.)
 - e) Those who acquired Turkish citizenship after being a foreign national/those with double citizenship in this situation,
 - f) Those who are Turkish nationals and have completed their entire high school education in a foreign country (except TRNC) (including those who have completed their entire high school education in Turkish schools in a foreign country other than the TRNC),
 - g) Those who are TRNC nationals, residing in the TRNC and have GCE Advanced Level exam results who have completed high school education in the TRNC, and
 - h) Those who are TRNC nationals and have or will have GCE Advanced Level exam results by enrolling in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and receiving education.
- (2) Applications of the candidates listed below shall not be accepted:
- a) Those who are Turkish nationals and have completed their entire high school education in Turkey or the TRNC,
 - b) TRNC nationals or dual nationals of which one is TRNC (except those who have GCE Advanced Level exam results).
 - c) Dual citizens whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in subparagraph (b) of paragraph 1 of Article 6, or Turkish nationals (except for those who have completed their last three years of secondary education (high school) if they started abroad (except TRNC) before 01/02/2013, and who completed their entire secondary education (high school) if they started after the mentioned date)
 - d) Turkish nationals studying at schools under the embassies in Turkey and foreign high schools in Turkey, or dual citizens whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of Article 6

ARTICLE 7- (1) Exams, diplomas and minimum scores recognized for application to university programs are listed in Annex-1. Meeting at least one of the conditions in this list is sufficient for application.

(2) Candidates who apply to the university's programs that accept students with a special talent exam must meet the conditions specified in Annex-1, as well as the requirement to be successful in the special talent exam of the relevant programs.

Foreign National Student Exam

ARTICLE 8- (1) LHUYOS is held at least once a year. The application dates for the exam, the method, content and date of the exam are specified in the Guide adopted by the Exam Preparation and Executive Committee.

(2) LHUYOS is conducted by the Exam Preparation and Executive Committee appointed by the Administrative Committee.

- (3) The coordination of the exam and the declaration of the results are carried out in line with the commission's decisions and instructions.
- (4) The result of LHUYOS shall be valid for one (1) year following the date of exam.
- (5) LHUYOS entrance fee is determined by the Board of Overseers of Lokman Hekim University.
- (6) Objection to the exam questions needs to be raised within five (5) business days from the opening of the questions, and objections to the exam results need to be raised within five (5) business days from the declaration of the exam results. Objections are decided by the Question Objection Committee formed by the Rector or the Exam Result Objection Committee, as applicable.
- (7) Objections to exam questions and exam results need to be raised in writing to the International Relations Office or via e-mail to yos@lokmanhekim.edu.tr. Written objections need to be delivered to the International Relations Office within the time specified in paragraph 6 of this article.

Applications and Required Documents for Application

ARTICLE 9- (1) Applications are made to Lokman Hekim University Registrar's Office between the dates specified in the Lokman Hekim University Academic Calendar, in person, via the online system or by mail (except e-mail).

(2) The required documents for application are listed below:

- 1- Application form (available on the website of University).
- 2- Turkish foreign mission certified-copy of the applicant's high school graduation diploma or temporary graduation certificate and the official transcript approved by the high school directorate showing the candidates' high school courses, grades and GPA, and Turkish translation certified by Turkish foreign representatives or notary public;
- 3- Turkish foreign mission certified-copy of the official document issued by the secondary education institution that shows the date of graduation for the applicants who are in the last year of high school and have not yet received their high school diploma, and Turkish translation of this document certified by Turkish foreign representatives or notary public,
- 4- Turkish foreign mission certified- or notarized copy of the exam result document showing the minimum scores specified in the national and/or international exams declared on the University's website, depending on the type of program applied by the applicants,
- 5- A copy of the pages of the passports of foreign applicants showing their identity information and validity period, and a copy of Turkish translation certified by Turkish foreign missions or notaries,
- 6- A copy of the register of the applicants of Turkish nationality certified by the civil registration offices, notary public or Turkish foreign representatives;
- 7- In case of applications made by those who are Turkish citizens by birth and who have a permit from the Ministry of Internal Affairs to renounce their Turkish citizenship, and those who certify that their underage children, who are registered in the certificate of renunciation of Turkish citizenship, certified copy of the document proving that the applicant may exercise the rights granted by Law No. 5203, certified by Turkish foreign representatives or notaries and the certified copy of the official identity card,
- 8- Certificate of identity register copy for those who are Turkish citizens by birth and who have a permit from the Ministry of Internal Affairs to renounce their Turkish citizenship and their underage children registered in the certificate of renunciation of Turkish citizenship,
- 9- For applications made by such applicants who are foreign nationals by birth and then have dual citizenship by transferring to Turkish nationality, a copy of the applicant's official identity card regarding foreign nationality and Turkish nationality, and a copy of the document indicating the date of transition to Turkish nationality, certified by the Turkish foreign representatives,

- 10- A certified copy of the applicant's Turkish proficiency certificate, if any,
- 11- Document showing that the applicant has the necessary financial means to continue education throughout the education period,
- 12- Two passport photographs.

(3) Additional documents may be requested by the University depending on the type of the undergraduate/associate degree programs applied for. These documents must be submitted at the time of final enrollment.

(4) The applications of the applicants who fail to meet the application conditions and to submit the information and documents required for the application in full within the required time shall be disqualified. After the application process is completed, no changes or additions may be made to the application information and documents.

Preliminary Review, Assessment and Placement

ARTICLE 10- (1) The preliminary review, assessment and placement of the candidates in the programs are made by the commission authorized by the Rectorate.

(2) Evaluation of applications and placement of candidates are entirely at the discretion of Lokman Hekim University. The university is free to fill the quota or not.

(3) Meeting the application conditions shall not mean being accepted for placement.

(4) Applications of applicants who are found not to meet the application requirements as a result of the preliminary review shall be disqualified.

Declaration of Results and Enrollment

ARTICLE 11- (1) The required documents to be provided by the applicants whose application is deemed appropriate, and the dates of enrollment and exam dates are declared on the official website of Lokman Hekim University.

(2) At the end of the assessment, a letter of acceptance is sent to the e-mail address of the applicant who is admitted to one of the programs applied for. If there is an obligation to obtain a student visa, a letter of acceptance is prepared and sent to the correspondence address.

(3) The followings are the required documents during enrollment:

- 1- The originals of the documents, approved copies of which the applicant submitted to the Registrar's Office at the time of application (only except for passport and official identity card);
- 2- Student visa issued by the Embassies or Consulates of the Republic of Türkiye, or if there are applicants with the status of foreigner who will not be asked for a student visa under the principles set by the General Directorate of Security, these candidates must submit an official document showing their status.
- 3- Eight 4,5×6,0 cm photographs (must be taken within the last six months, from the front, in a way that can easily introduce the candidate),
- 4- Bank receipt showing that the tuition fee has been paid to the relevant bank,
- 5- Signed Livelihood Assurance Statement
- 6- Document showing that there is valid health insurance in Türkiye,

(4) Holders of Turkish Pedigree Certificate must submit this document during enrollment. Subsequent submission of the document shall not change the status of the student at the time of final enrollment.

(5) All documents required for registration must be submitted completely during enrollment. Otherwise, the application shall be conditionally accepted.

(6) If it is determined that the documents required during the application and/or enrollment have been falsified or false documents have been provided, half of the tuition fee shall be recorded as revenue on behalf of the university as a penal clause.

Amount of Tuition Fee and Livelihood Assurance

ARTICLE 12- (1) The tuition fees to be collected from students who are accepted to higher education programs at Lokman Hekim University, scholarships, other financial matters, and the amount of assurance sufficient for these students to continue their education in Türkiye shall be determined and declared by the Board of Overseers every year.

(2) Whether the financial condition of foreign students admitted to Lokman Hekim University enable them to continue their education is entirely the student's responsibility.

(3) Students who do not have Turkish proficiency and students who are obliged to improve their Turkish level may attend TÖMER Turkish language courses, provided that the course fee is paid by the student, in accordance with the cooperation protocol between Lokman Hekim University and the Turkish Teaching Center/Centers (TÖMER).

(4) Students who do not have Turkish proficiency and will receive Turkish language education pay the annual fee of the program they are placed in in cash within the specified period. Students who fail to certify their language proficiency level at the end of two (2) years shall not be refunded.

Health Insurance

ARTICLE 13- (1) Students who are accepted to an undergraduate program within the scope of foreign student quotas must maintain a health insurance valid in Türkiye throughout their education.

Language of Education

ARTICLE 14- (1) The language of education at Lokman Hekim University is Turkish. It is important that our applicants have sufficient language proficiency so that they can follow and understand the lessons.

(2) The Turkish proficiency of those placed in an undergraduate program within the university shall be established by a document proving that the applicant is successful and obtained from Turkish education centers recognized by YOK.

(3) Students who do not have Turkish Proficiency shall receive Turkish language education. Applicants whose Turkish level is insufficient are obliged to improve their Turkish level to a sufficient level within a maximum of 2 (two) years. Students who are required to obtain Turkish Proficiency may start their education in the program they are enrolled in, by certifying their language proficiency at the end of a maximum of 2 (two) years.

(4) Assessment of Turkish proficiency level:

The applicants who are eligible for enrollment shall certify their Turkish proficiency level.

Students who fail to prove their Turkish proficiency level shall not be allowed to start education.

An acceptable Turkish proficiency certificate may be obtained from Turkish Language Education Research and Application Centers of Universities or Yunus Emre Institutes.

Assessment of Turkish proficiency levels;

Level C1: Turkish is sufficient. Eligible to start education at the University.

Level B2-B1: Turkish level is not sufficient, but may be improved. Provided that the student takes a Turkish course, they shall be enrolled in the undergraduate program for which they are eligible to enroll. However, the student shall certify that they have improved their Turkish level to C1 level by the beginning of the third academic year at the latest. At the end of this period, those whose Turkish is still at B2-B1 level may not continue their education until they improve their language level to C1 level. During this period, their enrollment shall be frozen.

Level A2-A1: There is no Turkish at all or it is insufficient. Such students reserve the right to enroll the undergraduate program they are eligible to enroll, and shall improve their Turkish level to level B1-B2 by the beginning of the third academic year at the latest to start their education.

However, they have to improve their Turkish proficiency level to level C1 during the additional 1 year period.

(4) The following table lists the European Language Portfolio Turkish Language Proficiency Levels (ADP) equivalents of Turkish Language Proficiency Levels:

PART THREE

Miscellaneous and Final Provisions, Situations for which there are no provisions

ARTICLE 14- (1) In case of situations for which there are no provisions in this Guidelines, the provisions of Legislation of the Council of Higher Education on the Admission of Students from Abroad, Lokman Hekim University Regulation on the Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education, and other legislation shall apply.

Enforcement

ARTICLE 15- (1) This Guidelines shall enter into force by the Senate's Decision on 24 April 2019.

Execution

ARTICLE 16- (1) The provisions of this Guidelines shall be executed by the Rector of the Lokman Hekim University.
